



Gelish Dip 1 Colour Application

- 1 Ensure nails are prepped with a 100 grit buffer for any nail overlay.
- 2 Using PREP all over nail to dehydrate nail plate.
- 3 Apply BASE in thin layer and dip in first color. Apply to all 10 fingers and thumbs to ensure complete drying of nail.
- 4 Dust off excess powder.
- 5 Apply second coat of BASE and dip in powder (as in step 3).
- 6 Dust off excess powder.
- 7 Apply ACTIVATOR to all 10 fingers and thumbs (use sparingly to avoid over drying of product)
- 8 Wipe nail with dry lint free wipe to remove any excess activator.
- 9 Apply BASE to all 10 fingers and thumbs. *Wipe off brush before placing back into bottle to avoid cross contamination of product and changing the integrity of BASE COAT.
- 10 Once dry, file side walls etc. and use 100 grit buffer file to buff nail. Wipe of excess dust. Buff with 180 grit buffer file to smooth out nail.
- 11 Apply ACTIVATOR. Apply this only on the product. DO NOT flood the cuticle, as this can weaken the product in this area. (Use sparingly to avoid over drying of product)
- 12 Wipe nail with dry lint free wipe to remove any excess activator.
- 13 Apply TOP Coat to all 10 fingers and thumbs. *Ensure you are wiping brush between each application. Like in step 9.
- 14 Apply TOP Coat to all 10 Fingers and thumbs.
- 15 Allow dry for 10-15mins.





Helpful Tips

*The angle of the brush when applying BASE coat must run horizontal to float product in between brush and nail. As opposed to a 45-degree angle when doing a normal polish or gel polish. The less pressure on the nail the better. As the second coat can collect excess powder from the nail onto the brush causing the brush to go hard when dried.

*The drying time can be effected by temperature.

*Wiping the brush before placing it back into the bottle will help keep the integrity of the BASE and TOP coat. Any cross contamination of the BRUSH RESTORER or ACTIVATOR into the TOP or BASE COAT will make them go stringy and clumpy. Therefore, too thick to paint onto the nail and dry.

***AVIOD** wiping the brush on top of the bottle as excess product will dry the lid shut. Instead wipe the brush on the inside of the bottle, so the product slides down back into the bottle.
